

# Voyageur District Scouter Awards Nomination Forms and Instructions

Tips for filling out the nomination forms for District Scouters:

1. In addition to the nomination form, also include the individual's Scouting Resume, if one is available. You might find this to be a useful tool for all of your adult leaders to update each year for your unit files (*page 4 of this file*).
2. Every scout deserves a trained leader. Being trained for their position is a critical factor in consideration for a district award and *awards will not be given if the person is not trained*.
3. Make sure the unit and current leadership position is clearly shown on the nomination form.
4. Review the "Guidelines for District Level Awards" (*page 2*) and indicate, in your write-up, if and how your nominee meets each of those points.
5. Start early and make sure your nomination is submitted before the January deadline. Spring is a very busy time and schedules fill up quickly. By meeting the deadline, you ensure that if your nominee receives an award, they can attend the recognition dinner and invite others to attend.

Note: Recipients of these awards will be recognized at the Spring Voyageur District Recognition Banquet.

## Guidelines for District Level Awards

These are guidelines to be used for a Scouters nomination. A Scouter does not need to meet all items listed to be qualified. Noteworthy activity not listed below may also be included for nominee's consideration.

### Rookie of the Year (1-4 given)

- ✓ Newly registered as an adult Scouter (less than 3 years)
- ✓ Trained
- ✓ Shows outstanding enthusiasm for Scouting
- ✓ Shows noteworthy involvement in Scouting
- ✓ Shows willingness to continue in Scouting program
- ✓ Shows growth in his/her Scouting position
- ✓ Attends Roundtables

### Square Knot Award (1-6 given)

- ✓ Two year minimum tenure
- ✓ Trained
- ✓ Shows outstanding enthusiasm for Scouting
- ✓ Shows noteworthy involvement in Scouting
- ✓ Supportive of district and council events
- ✓ Unit submits JTE on time annually
- ✓ Unit has active summer program
- ✓ Helps recruit leaders and youth
- ✓ Helps youth remain in Scouting
- ✓ Promotes advancement
- ✓ Helpful to other adult Scouters
- ✓ Attends Roundtables

### District Award of Merit (1-6 given)

The Award of Merit is a council award presented by the districts in the same manner that the Silver Beaver is a national award presented by councils. This Award is available to Scouters who render service of an outstanding nature at the district level.

- ✓ A nominee must be a registered Scouter
- ✓ A nominee must have rendered noteworthy service to youth in Scouting, outside Scouting, or both

Note: The nature and value of "noteworthy service to youth" may consist of a single plan or decisions that contributed vitally to the lives of large numbers of youth or it may have been given to a small group over an extended period of time.

- ✓ Consideration must be given to the nominee's Scouting position and the corresponding opportunity to render outstanding service beyond the expectations of that Scouting position.
- ✓ The nominee's attitude toward and cooperation with the district and/or council is to be taken into consideration.
- ✓ Nominations cannot be considered for posthumous awards.
