

TO ACCESS YOUTH PROTECTION TRAINING (YPT):

- Log into/create an account at: My.Scouting.org
- If you have never created an account in My.Scouting.org then click: **Create Account**
 - **The next screen will ask: *Are you already associated with the Boy Scouts of America?***
 - If you answer **Yes**, you will be asked if you know your Member ID number.
 - If you do not know your Member ID number, just answer No. The system will then search for your existing Scout record using other search criteria.
 - If you do know your Member ID number:
 - Answer Yes → Enter your Member ID number → Enter your birth date: MM/DD/YYYY *If the system can match the entered information to a record in the database the site will ask you validate the found record via your security questions or personal information.*
 - If you answer **No**, you will be asked to enter your information so the site can create your Scouting record. A member ID number will be assigned to you through this process.
- Then on the first page after login click on the Scouting U icon (middle, right side of the screen) This brings you the training site. Scroll down and click on the YPT logo under the blue text.



Looks like this:

- At the end of the program, save a PDF copy of your Certificate of Completion.
 - Please include a copy of this certificate with your Adult Leader application.
 - **Please note: All adult leaders are required by the Bay-Lakes Council to complete Youth Protection Training before becoming a registered BSA member.**
